Set within eight acres of beautiful landscaped grounds, Chesham Bois Manor is ideally situated close to Chesham town centre and all major amenities. Nearby are many shops, restaurants and places of interest as well as bus routes. The history of the flint stoned old Manor House dates back to William the Conqueror's time and has retained many of its original splendid features. The home offers residential care for the elderly as well as specialist environments named 'Woodlands' and 'The Orchard' for individuals who are experiencing living with a dementia.

The original house has been tastefully extended, furnished and equipped to a very high standard to provide accommodation on two levels. There is lift access to all floors. Residents have a choice of lounge and dining areas throughout the home including the charming oak panelled Library. A hair salon, treatment room, activities room and assisted bath and shower rooms have also been incorporated. There is easy access for residents to the extensive private gardens and shady courtyard garden and patio areas.

Most of the 48 rooms at Chesham Bois Manor are offered as single en-suite and residents are encouraged to personalise their rooms to create a sense of home from home, familiarity and belonging.

Residents may take meals in a choice of dining areas or if they wish, in the privacy of their own room. Our skilled resident cook prepares an extensive range of appetising home cooked meals, taking into account nutritional balances and any specific dietary requirements or individual preferences. There is always a choice of menu and refreshments and snacks are available 24hrs.

Life at Chesham Bois Manor is very much home from home and an active lifestyle is encouraged, with friends and relatives always welcome. The Activities and Lifestyle Facilitator arranges a varied social calendar of activities and entertainment in groups and on a one to one basis. We ensure that each of our residents receive meaningful occupation tailored to who they are. There is a weekly activities programme and monthly entertainment. The home has transport available for trips into the community e.g. supermarket, church, library, pub and social groups.
