The country house has been tastefully extended, furnished and equipped to a very high standard to provide accommodation on two levels. There is lift access to all floors. The specialist dementia environment 'The Cedars' provides accommodation on one level. Residents have a choice of lounge and dining areas including the magnificent oak panelled grand dining room. There is an oak panelled bar, conservatory, hair salon and sensory room for the residents to enjoy, together with assisted bathrooms and training room. There is easy access for residents to the extensive landscaped grounds, walkways, courtyards, log cabin and greenhouse.

All 67 rooms at Greenhill are offered as single en-suite and residents are encouraged to personalise their rooms to create a sense of home from home, familiarity and belonging.

Residents may take meals in a choice of dining areas or if they wish, in the privacy of their own room. Our skilled resident chef prepares an extensive range of appetising home cooked meals, taking into account nutritional balances and any specific dietary requirements or individual preferences.
