St Leonards is ideally situated within 1 mile of Aylesbury town centre. With easy access to bus services into the town centre and just a short drive from the village of Wendover and the town of Tring. The home offers residential care for the elderly and a specialist environment for individuals who are experiencing living with a dementia.

St Leonards is a purpose built care home that has been tastefully furnished and equipped to a very high standard. Accommodation is provided over two floors and the specialist dementia environment 'The Willows', provides accommodation on one level. There is lift access to all floors. A computer lounge, hair salon, tea room and assisted bathrooms have also been incorporated. There is easy access for residents to the landscaped gardens, walkways, patios, courtyards, log cabin and greenhouse.

All 45 rooms at St Leonards are offered as single en-suite and residents are encouraged to personalise their rooms to create a sense of home from home, familiarity and belonging.

Residents may take meals in a choice of dining areas or if they wish, in the privacy of their own room. Our skilled resident catering manager prepares an extensive range of appetising home



cooked meals, taking into account nutritional balances and any specific dietary requirements or individual preferences. There is always a choice of menu and refreshments, snacks are available throughout the day.
