



# The Lodge Care Home Hemel Hempstead, Herts

The Lodge is ideally situated in a quiet residential street in the Old Town area of Hemel Hempstead, very close to all major amenities. Nearby are many shops, restaurants and places of interest as well as bus and rail connections. The Lodge was originally a beautiful detached Victorian Villa and many of its original features have been retained. The home offers residential care for the elderly and for individuals who are experiencing living with a dementia.

The original house has been tastefully extended, furnished and equipped to a very high standard to provide accommodation on four levels. There is lift access to all floors. Residents have a choice of lounge and dining areas throughout the home, a hair salon, assisted bath and shower rooms have also been incorporated. There is easy access for residents to the private courtyard gardens and shady patio areas.

All 46 rooms at The Lodge are offered as single en-suite and residents are encouraged to personalise their rooms to create a sense of home from home, familiarity and belonging.

Residents may take meals in a choice of dining areas or if they wish, in the privacy of their own room. Our skilled resident cook prepares

an extensive range of appetising home cooked meals, taking into account nutritional balances and any specific dietary requirements or individual preferences. There is always a choice of menu and refreshments and snacks are available 24hrs.

Life at The Lodge is very much home from home and an active lifestyle is encouraged, with friends and relatives always welcome. The Activities and Lifestyle Facilitator arranges a varied social calendar of activities and entertainment in groups and on a one to one basis. We ensure that each of our residents receive meaningful occupation tailored to who they are. There is a weekly





activities programme and monthly entertainment. The home has transport available for trips into the community e.g. supermarket, church, library, pub and social groups.
